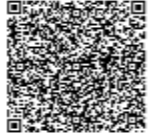

HARPREET SINGH BRAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to restrain the police officials of Police Station Kosli, who in connivance with respondent No.4, are harassing the petitioner (minor girl) by visiting her house time and again.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, *inter alia*, contends that an FIR No.154 dated 11.06.2024 under Sections 120-B, 406, 420, 467, 498 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, was registered at Police Station Kosli, District Rewari against parents of the petitioner. The petitioner is minor and on 19.06.2024, some police officials came to her shop and when asked about her

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parents, she told that they had gone to Najafgarh and will come back after one week. On coming to know that the petitioner is residing alone with her younger brother and sister and her parents will come back after one week, respondent No.5 came to her house and misbehaved with her and also threatened to abduct her. On 21.06.2024, three police officials in civil dress entered into shop of the petitioner forcibly and on asking by them, she provided the address of Delhi and requested them not to harass her. On 22.06.2024, at about 08.00 p.m., three police officials forcibly entered house of the petitioner and respondent No.5 again misbehaved with her. On making the noise, they fled away and while leaving, respondent No.5 threatened to abduct her. Thereafter, on making a phone call to police helpline number by the petitioner, some police officials came to her house and they intimated the entire incident to the higher police officials and they also assured the petitioner about her safety. When the petitioner along with grandmother (nani) and aunt (mausi) went to Police Station Kosli to get the complaint registered, the police officials of said police station, including respondent No.5, misbehaved with them and turned them out of the police station. Having left with no other option, the petitioner sent a representation dated 24.06.2024 (Annexure P-1) to respondent No.2, but till date, no action has been taken thereon.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 24.06.2024 (Annexure P-1)



submitted by her in a time bound manner.

- 4. Notice of motion to the official respondents only.
- 5. On asking of the Court, Ms. Geeta Sharma, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply copy of complete paperbook to learned State counsel during course of the day.
- 6. Keeping in view the prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 24.06.2024 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
