1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 22.07.2022 passed in CWP-15663-2022.
2. Reply by way of affidavit of Uma Shankar Gupta, Director, Local Government, Punjab, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 22.07.2022 passed in CWP-15663-2022 has been complied with and legal notice of the petitioner has been decided by passing the speaking order dated 05.10.2023 (Annexure R-1/T).
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
