Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to the respondents to allow the registration of new Motor BS-IV Car bearing Temporary Registration No.CH87(T) 6028, make Tata Zest XM bearing Chassis No.MAT624031KPC01235 and Engine No. 100A2000074110 purchased by the petitioner from Berkeley Tata Motors, Chandigarh on 21.12.2019 and got temporary registration certificate on the same date, however, the same could not be registered upto the cut-off date i.e. 31.03.2020 due to sudden imposition of lockdown/curfew during Covid-19 Pandemic situation.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the issue involved in the present case is covered by the order of even date passed by this Court in **CWP-21562-2020** titled as '**Heena Talwar Vs. U.T. Chandigarh and others**' and prays to dispose of the present petition in the same terms.

A perusal of the case file clearly shows that the temporary registration number of the vehicle was allotted to the petitioner and the transaction in the present case had taken place much prior to 31.03.2020.

Learned counsel opposite do not dispute the same.

Since the parties do not dispute that the issue involved in the present case is covered by the aforesaid order passed in case of **Heena Talwar** (supra), the present writ petition is **disposed of** in terms of order of even date i.e. 22.02.2024 passed in case of **Heena Talwar** (supra).
