Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are working as Ancillary Staff in various Govt. Hospitals and Medical Colleges and their services are not being regularized with the further prayer that their salary should also be increased by at least 33% as being done in case of Staff Nurses whereas, the salary of the Ancillary Staff has been increased only by 10%, which action of the respondents is discriminatory & arbitrary.

Learned State counsel submits that the said claim of the petitioners is already under consideration of the Government and an appropriate order is likely to be passed.



Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the present petition was filed in the year 2018 and six years have passed but the respondents have not decided the case, which is causing prejudice to them.

Keeping in view the fact that the learned State counsel has submitted that the claim of the petitioners for regularization and for enhancement of their salary, who are working as Ancillary Staff, is under consideration, let the said consideration be finalized within a period of six months after the receipt of copy of this order and in case, the petitioners are found entitled for any benefit, the same be released, otherwise due reasons will be given for not accepting the claim of the petitioners, which reasons be also conveyed to the petitioners for their information and necessary action.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the direction given by this Court as recorded here-in-before, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
