This petition has been filed praying for issuance of direction to respondent No.5-Deputy Commissioner, SBS Nagar to get demarcate the land of the petitioner as per order dated 30.08.2016 (Annexure P-7) from respondent No.6. Further prayer has been made for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to provide protection and adequate police help to protect the wheat crop of the petitioner from the hands of respondents No.4 and 8 to 12. Further prayer has been made for direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to check the respondent No.4 to enter in the filed of petitioner along with private persons. Further prayer has been made for direction to respondent No.6 to initiate proceedings under Section 145 (8) Cr.P.C. during the pendency of demarcation proceedings.

On the issuance of notice, respondents have filed their reply.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the demarcation as prayed for by the petitioner in this petition has already been carried out and the report dated 04.09.2020 has been placed on record as Annexure R-1/T. He submits that demarcation has been carried out in the presence of the petitioner and other parties as is evident from Annexure R-2/T. It is submitted that the grievance raised by the petitioner has already been redressed and thus, the present petition is rendered infructuous.

After hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, the present petition is disposed of as infructuous. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to pursue her remedy in case any further grievance survives.
