AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioners Sukhpreet Kaur and Gurwinder Singh have filed instant petition under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India for directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 8.
2. It was alleged that both petitioners are major. Copies of their Aadhar Card are Annexure P-1 and P-2. They had performed marriage on 27.06.2024. Copy of their marriage certificate is Annexures P-3. Petitioners also moved representation to Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna which is Annexure P-4. Petitioners had performed marriage without the consent and wishes of parents and other family members of petitioner No.1, from whom, petitioners were receiving threats.
3. On this petition, notice was given and status report was called for.
4. Status report filed according to which both petitioners suffered their statement that they are residing happily and have no threat from anyone.



5. In view of the status report, counsel for petitioners stated that now there is no apprehension of threat and their petition may be disposed of as same is rendered infructuous.

6. Since at present there is no threat perception to petitioners, therefore, present petition stands disposed of having rendered infructuous. However, in case there is any threat perception in the mind of present petitioners they can approach respondent Nos.2 and 3 who will consider threat perception and will take necessary steps.

7. With these directions petition is, accordingly, disposed of.

8. Pending application (s), if any also stands disposed of.
