AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Vishal Atre and Aryan Atre have filed anticipatory bail in FIR No.130 dated 15.06.2024, under Sections 353, 186, 506, 427, 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station City Jagraon, District Ludhiana.

2. As per the facts of case, FIR has been registered on the statement of Sikander Singh who was serving in the office of Municipal Council, Jagraon near Nodel Complex Centre of Punjab State Power Corporation Limited. Occurrence took place on 14.06.2024 at about 11:40 when he along with his fellow employees was present in the office and Vishal Atre and Aryan Atre visited the office and created scene for not attending the complaint on phone. It was alleged that a scuffle took place and computer and their phone lying in the office were damaged.

3. Learned counsel for petitioners argued that petitioners were

granted interim bail vide order dated 01.07.2024 and in pursuance to this order, they have joined investigation. Therefore, their interim bail already granted may be confirmed.

4. Learned counsel representing State has filed status report, which is taken on record. As per status report, present petitioners have joined investigation and case property is also taken into police possession. Learned counsel representing State on instructions from ASI Rajbir Singh, City Jagraon confirmed that petitioners have joined investigation and they are not required for any other purpose.

5. Considering the aforesaid factual position, no purpose would be served by sending present petitioners behind the bars. They are ready to join investigation and abide by the terms of bail. Therefore, without expressing my mind on merits of the case, interim bail already granted to petitioners-Vishal Atre and Aryan Atre vide order dated 01.07.2024 stands confirmed subject to the conditions specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

6. Petition is accordingly allowed.

7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
