AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioners Anjli Devi and Rohit have filed present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect life and liberty of petitioners from the hands of respondents No.4 to 7 who are family members/relatives of petitioner No.1.

2. In compliance to previous order dated 01.07.2024, learned State counsel has filed status report, which is taken on record.

3. As per status report, statements of respondents No.4 to 6 have been recorded where they stated that petitioners have performed marriage against their wishes. They have no objection to their marriage and they will not interfere in their matrimonial life. Statements of petitioners are also recorded who confirmed their marriage against the wishes of their parents and family members. They confirmed that they are living happily and they do not need any protection. Along with the status report translated copy of



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statements of Vikas, Pradeep Kumar and Harbans Lal are annexed as Annexure R-1 to R-3 and statements of petitioners Anjli and Rohit are annexed as Annexure R-4 and R-5.

4. As per the statements of petitioners and respondents No.4 to 6 now petitioners do not apprehend any threat to their life and liberty. Therefore, present petition stands disposed of having rendered infructuous.

5. Petition is accordingly disposed of.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
