The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in a case bearing FIR No.176 dated 08.10.2022 under Sections 307, 160, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 323, 324, 506 IPC (added later on) registered at Police Station Division No.2, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim orders dated 05.07.2024 and 29.07.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the orders dated 05.07.2024 and 29.07.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

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In view of the above, the interim order dated 05.07.2024 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
