HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J.(ORAL)

1. In the present petition, at the outset, learned counsel for respondent No.1 submits that the present petition is not maintainable as the claim of the petitioner is against respondent No.2-college which is a private college and for all the disputes between an employee and the management of a private institution, the remedy is available before the Educational Tribunal, Punjab.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the objection raised, the petitioner is ready to avail the remedy before the Educational Tribunal, Punjab but, as the pleading in the present petition has already been completed, the paper-book of the present petition be sent to the Educational Tribunal, Punjab for considering the claim of the petitioner and passing the appropriate orders so as to save the precious time of the



Tribunal in completing the same pleadings again.

- 3. Learned counsel for respondent No.1 raises no objection.
- 4. Keeping in view the above, as prayed for, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail the remedy before the Educational Tribunal, Punjab. The Registry is directed to send the paper book of the present petition to the Educational Tribunal, Punjab for considering the claim of the petitioner and passing appropriate orders on the claim of the petitioner.
- 5. The parties are directed to appear before the Educational Tribunal, Punjab on 19.12.2024.
