Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to the respondents to allow the registration of new Motor BS-4 Vehicle/Car, Make HYUNDAI i20 (Diesel), Chassis No.MALBM51BLKM659252 and Engine No.G4LAJM165420, purchased from authorized dealer namely Charisma Goldwheels (P) Ltd., Phase 1, Chandigarh, on 17.02.2019, which could not be registered upto the cut-off date i.e. 31.03.2020 due to sudden imposition of lockdown/curfew during Covid-19 Pandemic situation.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the issue involved in the present case is covered by the order of even date passed by this Court in **CWP-21562-2020** titled as '**Heena Talwar Vs.**

U.T. Chandigarh and others’ and prays to dispose of the present petition in the same terms.

A perusal of the case file clearly shows that the transaction in the present case had taken place much prior to 31.03.2020.

Learned counsel opposite do not dispute the same.

Since the parties do not dispute that the issue involved in the present case is covered by the aforesaid order passed in case of **Heena Talwar** (supra), the present writ petition is **disposed of** in terms of order of even date i.e. 22.02.2024 passed in case of **Heena Talwar** (supra).
