1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to release the remaining amount of service-cum-retirement dues of the petitioner including Gratuity, Provident Fund, Leave Encashment, 24, 32 years increments of ACP Scheme, revised pay scale, arrears and all other benefits along with interest for delayed period.

2. In para 7 of the written statement filed on behalf of respondent No.3, , it has been stated as under:-

" That the contents of Para No.7 of the Civil Writ Petition are matter of record regarding the amount transferred by the Government to the Municipal Corporation. However, it is vehemently denied that the petitioner has not been paid amount of his provident fund amounting to Rs.3,84,254/-. The petitioner has already been paid the amount of Rs.4,03,941/- on 14.10.2023 including up to date



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interest. The payment of arrear of 6th Pay Commission amounting to Rs.33,221/- has also been paid to the petitioner."

- 3. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.
- 4. Dismissed as withdrawn.
