1. In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the work on the post on which the petitioner was working, still exist and therefore, the respondents are liable to be directed to allow the petitioner to continue in service and not to dispense her services.

2. Learned State counsel, on the instructions from Mr. Paramjit Singh, Assistant Director, submits that the availability of the work will be assessed and whether the services of the petitioner can be utilized in any of the Department where she has already worked for the last seven years, will be ascertained and in case, it is found that the petitioner's service can be utilized, the petitioner will be allowed to continue in service till her services

are needed otherwise due orders will be passed giving reasons for not

accepting the claim of the petitioner so as to allow her to continue, which will be conveyed to the petitioner as well for her information.
