1. Rajbeer Singh has filed anticipatory bail in FIR No.0083 dated 31.03.2023 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 420, 406, 34 of IPC and Section 24 of the Immigration Act, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Bathinda.

2. As per the facts of the case, Pinki Rani filed written complaint alleging that accused persons Harpreet Singh and others running their office in the name of Eurocan Global and Immigration Office Ludhiana and they cheated her for a sum of Rs.11-12 Lakhs on the pretext of sending her abroad. Accused persons had admitted their fault and issued 03 post dated cheques to return money with the assurance that the cheques will be

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honoured. On presentation, said cheques were bounced. Thereafter, she contacted the accused persons to return her money. They entered into a compromise to evade the proceedings in the complaint. They had no intention to return the money. They are involved in several other cases. With these allegations matter was enquired and the present FIR was registered.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner raised the issue that matter has been compromised and the written compromise dated 09.09.2024 is Annexure P-11. All misunderstanding between the parties has been cleared. He will also join the investigation. It is prayed that his anticipatory bail application may be allowed.

4. Learned counsel representing State had filed detailed status report dated 13.08.2024 opposing the anticipatory bail application filed by the petitioner. It was further alleged that he was involved in 07 other FIRs. Petitioner had received and misappropriated a sum of Rs.4,50,000/- being partner of Eurocan Global and Immigration Office as mentioned in para No.8 of the status report. Thereafter, supplementary status report dated 30.09.2024 has been filed confirming the fact that matter has been compromised vide compromise/affidavit dated 09.09.2024 and the same is taken on record.

5. Considering the aforesaid factual position, matter has been compromised and the same is also confirmed in the aforesaid status report dated 30.09.2024. Even otherwise, petitioner is ready to join the investigation as and when required. Therefore, no purpose would be served by sending the petitioner behind the bars. Accordingly, anticipatory

bail petition filed by petitioner – Rajbeer Singh is allowed. He be not

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arrested. In case of his arrest, he be released on bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer concerned, subject to condition that petitioner will join investigation as and when required. He will not tamper with or interfere with investigation and will not leave country without prior permission as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
