1. Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing respondent No.1 to transfer its contribution towards pension, gratuity and leave encashment to respondent No.2.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset confines his prayer for deciding legal notice dated 18.05.2024 (Annexure P-9). He submits that at this stage, petitioner would be satisfied, if the said legal notice is considered and decided by passing a speaking order in a time-bound frame.
3. Notice of motion to respondent No.1 only at this stage.
4. Mr. Deepak Gupta, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1.
5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the present petition, respondent No.1 is directed to consider and decide the claim made by the petitioner in legal notice dated 18.05.2024 (Annexure P-9) in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
7. The petition stands disposed of.
