1. The present is a writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of *certiorari* for setting aside the order dated 07.05.2018 (Annexure P-12) whereby the claim of the petitioner was declined with further prayer seeking writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the concerned department to provisionally allow the petitioner for Scrutiny of documents and thereafter call him for further interview process which was scheduled to be held on 09.05.2018 and selection process is still going on, notified vide Annexure P-7.

2. The case of the petitioner was that the last selected candidate had secured 152 marks in the written examination and since the petitioner was having more than the aforesaid marks, he was wrongly not called for the interview.

3. In pursuance of the order dated 26.02.2024 passed by this Court, learned State Counsel has supplied the records with regard to the answer given by the petitioner and answer key as prepared by the Commission and the aforesaid records were supplied to the petitioner under the supervision of the officer, who is present in Court today and the aforesaid records were inspected by the learned counsel for the petitioner as well.
4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has now made a statement that the petitioner’s marks in written examination were much lower than the last selected candidate i.e. less than 152 marks and he does not wish to press the present petition and prays for withdrawal of the same.
5. Dismissed as withdrawn.
