On request, the instant matter taken in National Lok Adalat,
accordingly discussed.

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the
appellant(s) and learned counsel for the Insurance Company (separately
recorded), a sum of Rs.4,80,000/- (Rupees four Lakh eighty Thousand only)
over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the
appellant(s) in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the
statement of learned counsel for the appellant(s), the enhanced amount be
paid to Kanta Devi widow of appellant Rajbir Singh (Since deceased).

Accordingly, we dispose of this appeal with a direction to the
Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for 4,80,000/- (Rupees four
Lakh eighty Thousand only) in the name of Kanta Devi widow of appellant
Rajbir Singh (Since deceased) with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High
Court within 45 days from today, in compliance of this order, failing
which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment
from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat
Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned

appellant(s) counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat of High Court.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
