The petitioner has approached this Court for seeking issuance of directions to respondent No.2-District Food Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs Controller, Karnal to release the physical possession of the rented wooden crates given on rent in terms of the letter No.995 dated 22.04.2019 (Annexure P-1) alongwith a further direction to the respondents to release the outstanding rent as per the detailed calculation dated 01.08.2021.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the respondents have already partially released the payment but there are certain disputes that still remain with respect to the outstanding amount, the possession of the crates as also his claim with respect to the interest, if so advised. He submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition so as to submit a comprehensive representation to the respondents raising all subsisting grievance and that a direction be issued to the respondents to pass a speaking order on such representation.

Learned State Counsel has no objection to the abovesaid prayer.

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Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to submit a comprehensive representation to respondent No.2- District Food Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs Controller, Karnal raising all his subsisting grievances.

Needless to mention that in the event of the petitioner submitting any such representation, respondent No.2- District Food Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs Controller, Karnal shall pass an reasoned and speaking order thereupon after granting an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of such representation.
