Prayer in the present petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of direction to the official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners from the respondents No.4 to 9 as the petitioners have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 10 and respondents No.4 to 10 are against the same.
2. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that - they married with their own free will.
3. Short reply on behalf of respondents No.4 to 7 filed in Court is taken on record stating therein that they have no concern with the petitioners. It is further mentioned in the affidavit that respondents No.4 to 7 have neither threatened the petitioners nor they have ever interfered in their lives as they have cut off all their relations with petitioner No.1.
4. In view of the above, there is no threat to the petitioners and as

such the present petition is disposed of as infructuous.
