LISA GILL, J.

1. Prayer in this appeal is for setting aside order dated 23.02.2023 whereby writ petition filed by appellant (writ petitioner) seeking parity of pay with Sanitary Inspectors working in the Department of Health and Local Self Government has been dismissed.

2. Learned counsel for appellant is unable to deny that no ground is made out for interference in view of decision dated 23.02.2011 passed in *LPA-351-2010 titled as State of Punjab and others versus Shil Kumar Mariya and others*. Appellant had placed reliance upon decision dated 06.03.2009 in *CWP-625-1997 titled as Shil Kumar Mariya and others versus*

State of Punjab and others. This decision dated 06.03.2009 was set aside in appeal i.e. LPA-351-2010 on 23.02.2011.

3. Learned counsel for appellant is unable to point out any distinction which calls for different dispensation in this appeal.
4. Appeal is, accordingly, dismissed. As the matter has been considered and decided on merits, adjudication upon application seeking condonation of delay of 100 days in filing the appeal, is rendered academic. Application is disposed of accordingly.
