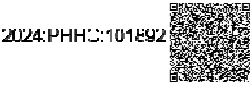
NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. Instant writ petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to decide the statutory departmental appeal dated 30.04.2024 (Annexure P-4) against order dated 14.07.2023 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.1, whereby provisional pension of the petitioner has been ordered to be withdrawn, in a time-bound manner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for deciding the appeal dated 30.04.2024 (Annexure P-4) filed by the petitioner expeditiously by passing a speaking order in a time-bound manner.
