RAJESH BHARDWAJ, J. (ORAL)

Present writ petition has been filed for directing the respondents to allot the adjacent strip of land which is in possession of the petitioners from a very long period, as similar types of adjacent strips of lands have already been ordered to be allotted to similarly situated persons and this Court have decided the matter LPA No.689 of 1992 for allotment @ Rs.500/- per sq. yards along with interest.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioners be directed to file representation within a period of two weeks before respondent No.2 and respondent No.2 i.e. the Tehsildar (Sales)-cum-Managing Officer, Rehabilitation Department, Faridabad will decide the same in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners may be allowed to file representation as stated above within a period of two weeks from today and respondent No.2 i.e. the Tehsildar (Sales)-cum-Managing Officer, Rehabilitation Department, Faridabad may be directed to decide the same in a time bound manner after considering the contentions raised therein and also the hardship faced by the petitioners during the Covid-19 period.

Heard.

After hearing counsel for both the parties and perusing the record, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file representation for redressal of his grievance before respondent No.2 within a period of two weeks from today. If any such representation is filed by the petitioner within the stipulated period, then respondent No.2 i.e. the Tehsildar (Sales)-cum-Managing Officer, Rehabilitation Department, Faridabad would take into consideration the grievances raised by the petitioner in his representation to be filed mentioning therein the consequences of Covid-19 faced by them and decide the same as per law within a period of two months from the date of filing the representation.
