HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions, undertakes that the benefits payable to the petitioners by counting their services with the private aided institutions towards pensionary benefits shall be released within a period of two weeks from today.
2. In view of the above, learned counsel for petitioners submits that he does not want to press the present petition.
3. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed being not pressed. Rule stands discharged.
4. However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per the undertaking, the petitioners would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the
