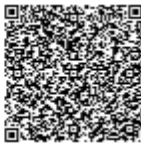
Prayer in the present application is for placing on record the

CWP-14362-2017:

The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the
Constitution of India, inter alia, seeking a writ in the nature of *Certiorari* for
setting aside orders dated 02.07.2014, 24.11.2015 and 22.05.2017
(Annexures P-4, P-6 and P-7 respectively) passed by respondents No.4, 3
and 2 respectively.



2. On 02.04.2024, the following order was passed:

“ Though last opportunity was granted by this Court to the learned counsel for the petitioners on 18.08.2023, still the counsel appearing for the petitioners has prayed for an adjournment.

On her request, adjourned to 12.07.2024.

It is made clear that no further adjournment shall be granted.”

3. Thereafter, on 12.07.2024, the case was simply adjourned at the request of learned State counsel for 06.09.2024.

4. On the last date of hearing i.e. 06.09.2024, the following order was passed:

“On written request circulated by learned counsel for petitioner, adjourned to 22.11.2024.”

5. Today, despite second call, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners. It appears that the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant matter any further.

6. In view of the above, the instant petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
