1. Application is allowed as prayed for.
2. Order dated 05.07.2024 passed by respondent No.1, is taken on record as Annexure P-32.

Main Case

3. Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is *inter alia* for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing orders dated 25.02.2021 and 05.03.2020, Annexures P-1 and P-2, as well as consequential orders, Annexures P-27 and P-30, whereby petitioner's property is being put to auction.
4. Mr. Talwar submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this Court, the proceedings were taken up by respondent No.1 on



05.07.2024 and after hearing, order (Annexure P-32) has been passed, whereby it has been directed that auction proceedings shall be stayed, in case, the petitioner deposits 50% of the deficient stamp duty within a period of six days i.e. on or before 5.00 PM on 11.07.2024. He submits that the total deficient stamp duty works out to Rs.1.79 crore and the petitioner is not in a position to deposit 50% of the amount within a short period of time. In any case, he has instructions to state that the petitioner intends to challenge the said order by filing a separate petition. He seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with a further request that the auction proceedings, which are scheduled for 12.07.2024 be postponed and he be given sufficient time to take recourse to the remedies available to him in accordance with law.

6. Prayer made by the petitioner is just and fair and deserves to be acceded to.

7. Writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid. Auction proceedings which are fixed for 12.07.2024 be deferred to a date beyond 31st July, 2024.
