Prayer in the present petition is for quashing the FIR No.294 dated 18.12.2019, registered under Section 12 of the Passport Act, 1967 at Police Station Sirhind, District Fatehgarh Sahib and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 29.12.2023 (Annexure P-2).

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that after the registration of the impugned FIR, cancellation report was filed, however, the same was rejected. He submits that as on date, both the sides have entered into a compromise (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion.

Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State and on instructions from ASI Zagroop Singh, has submitted that again the cancellation report has been prepared and the same would be presented before the Court of competent jurisdiction within two weeks.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with



liberty to the petitioner to avail her remedy before the Court where the cancellation report would be presented. The Investigating Agency is directed to present the cancellation report, if so prepared, before the Competent Court within a period of two weeks from today. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to pursue her remedy further in case any adverse order is passed against her.
