LISA GILL, J.

1. Prayer in this writ petition is for quashing declaration of loan account of petitioners as Non Performing Asset (NPA) on 31.03.2021 and for quashing impugned demand notice as well as all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom under Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 (SARFAESI Act).
2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that this writ petition is rendered infructuous as petitioners account has been settled and closed.
3. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that she does not have any instructions in the matter.
4. Be that as it may, we do not find any justification for continuance of present proceedings, in view of categoric statement by learned counsel for respondents.

5. Writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of as infructuous with liberty to petitioners to file appropriate application within four weeks in case, any incorrect fact has been set forth before this Court.
