ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that the subject site/ plot was originally allotted to one Satpal, in an open auction on June 30, 2011. She submits that although the petitioner claims to have purchased the said site from Satpal, but the necessary approvals/sanctions in this regard were never obtained from the respondent-authorities. At any rate, she submits, vide resolution No.374, dated February 21, 2019 (R-1), the site in question was resumed and the resolution passed by the respondent-Trust was approved by the Government on March 8, 2019. Not just that, the said decision was even conveyed to the original allottee on March 18, 2019 (R-2). She asserts that the order of resumption was never assailed either by the original allottee or the petitioner in the present case.

Be that as it may, for none appears on behalf of the petitioner to pursue the matter, the Court is choice-less but to dismiss the petition for non-prosecution.

Ordered accordingly.
