NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the impugned recovery, as communicated vide letter dated 16.02.2011 (Annexure P-15 Colly) which is based on the orders dated 12.10.1994 and 17.04.2002 (Annexures P-8 & P-10) and further to hold the action of the respondents reducing the pay of the petitioner on refixation retrospectively.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents has produced copy of the Finance Circular No.14/2016 dated 22.09.2016, whereby the impugned circulars dated 12.10.1994 and 17.04.2002 (Annexure P-8 & P-10) have been withdrawn and necessary benefits have been released to the widow of the petitioner. He further submits that in view of the said fact, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
3. The abovesaid fact has also been affirmed by learned counsel for the petitioner.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.
