Petitioner is one of the defendants of Civil Suit No.581 of 2020, titled as “*Bharti Sharma v. Birla Sharma and another*”, pending in the Court of learned Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), SBS Nagar.

2. The short prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner is for directing the Trial Court for early disposal of the matter. Learned counsel has drawn attention towards the fact that an application under Order 6 Rule 17, Order 1 Rule 9(2) read with Section 151 CPC for amendment of plaint was moved way back on 07.01.2023 and despite lapse of more than 01 year and 06 months, even that application has not been disposed of so far. The matter is now fixed before the Trial Court for 30.07.2024. Even issues have not been settled till date despite lapse of 04 years from the filing of the suit.

3. Without issuing any notice to the other party, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Trial Court to positively decide the application for amendment of the plaint on 30.07.2024, the date already fixed thereat. If for any reason whatsoever, it is not possible to dispose of the

application on 30.07.2024, the same shall be disposed of within next 15 days

positively. The Trial Court is further directed to take necessary steps for expeditious disposal of the case, considering the age of petitioner-defendant No.2 as well as respondent-plaintiff, who are above 70 years of age.
