ANIL KSHETARPAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash order passed on 24.12.2019 (Annexure P-4) by respondent No.2.

2. The dispute is with regard to allotment of a LPG distributorship at District Sangrur. During the pendency of the writ petition, the distributorship has been allocated to Sh. Sudhir Singla on the basis of draw held on 06.11.2020.

3. On 13.11.2024, as well as on 28.11.2024, learned counsel representing the petitioner did not come forward to assist the Court. On 29.11.2024, the petitioner's counsel prayed for an adjournment to file application to implead Sh. Sudhir Singla as respondent. No application for impleadment has been filed yet.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court is not inclined to keep the writ petition pending. The petitioner, if so advised, may file a fresh writ petition challenging allotment of the LPG distributorship to Sh. Sudhir Singla.

5. With these observations, the petition is disposed of.
