1. This application has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1873 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') for placing on record the judgment dated 29.11.2023 passed by learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Camp Court, Pataudi, Gurugram as Annexure R-1.
2. In view of the averments made in the application, same is allowed and judgment dated 29.11.2023 passed by learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Camp Court, Pataudi, Gurugram is taken on record as Annexure R-1 subject to all just exceptions.

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3. Present revision petition has been preferred against the impugned order dated 08.05.2019 passed by learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Camp Court, Pataudi, Gurugram, vide which, in the petition filed under Section 125 Cr.P.C., interim maintenance of Rs.10,000/- per month and Rs.5,000/- per month was awarded to be paid to the respondents, respectively.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that since vide judgment dated 29.11.2023 (Annexure P-1) passed by learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Camp Court, Pataudi, Gurugram, final maintenance of Rs.15,000/- per month (*Rs.8,000/- per month to respondent No.1 and Rs.7,000/- per month to respondent No.2*) has been awarded in favour of the respondents, present petition has been rendered infructuous.

5. In view of the above, present revision petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

6. All the pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
