RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 2 read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 17.03.2023 passed in CWP-5543-2023.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Amritdeep Singh, Executive Engineer, Water Supply and Sanitation Division, Abohar, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the respondents have paid the necessary amounts to the petitioner and, therefore, the present petition has become infructuous. However, there may be some claim outstanding, therefore, the petitioner be permitted to raise the dispute in such a situation.
4. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed having been rendered infructuous. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, it would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
