1. On 07.07.2023, the following order was passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court:-

“Instant petition has been filed under Section 438, Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in:-

FIR	Dated	Police Station	Sections
330	20.12.2022	Model Town, Hoshiarpur	4420, 406, IPC, and Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act, 2014.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegation levelled against the petitioner and the co-accused is that they duped the complainant of Rs.15 lacs on the pretext of sending his son to Canada, but the allegation is false as the petitioner had arranged for a Canadian and Dubai Visa for complainant, as is evident from Annexure P-3. Still further, he submits that all the three coaccused have been granted anticipatory bail by this Court and the petitioner, who is a young lady and is a registered travel agent, is ready to join the investigation and co-operate with the Investigating Agency.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Arun Luthra, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

List on 18.09.2023.

Petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 24.07.2023 at 10.00 A.M. at Police Station Model Town, Hoshiarpur, and join the investigation and appear as and when called by the Investigating Officer. In the event of arrest, she shall be admitted to interim bail on furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. She shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions imparted to him by ASI Sukhjinder Singh, submits that the petitioner has already joined the investigation in pursuance to the aforesaid order, and she has fully co-operated with the investigation process, and is no more required for any further custodial investigation.

3. In view of the specific stand taken by the learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed, and order dated 07.07.2023 is, hereby, made absolute.
