1. Challenge in the present writ petition is to the order dated 15.07.2022 (Annexure P-5) on the ground that the service was not effected. Detailed affidavits have been filed.

2. Counsel for the petitioner, at this stage, submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file an appeal before the Appellate Authority against the above said order raising all the tenable grounds which are available to the petitioner.

3. Counsel for the State has no objection to the proposed line of action.

4. Keeping in view the above, the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to avail its alternative remedy in accordance with law provided the appeal is filed within a period of 4 weeks from today. Needless to say, we have not commented on the merits of the case. If the needful is done within the prescribed period, the Appellate

Authority shall hear the appeal on merits provided it is filed within the prescribed period alongwith deposit of the requisite amount.
