1. The petitioner through the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of Compassionate Ground Appointment Policy dated 27.06.2007 (Annexure P-3).
2. Mr. Sanjeev Kaushik, Advocate for respondent Nos. 2 to 4 submits that petitioner has directly approached this Court whereas in terms of notification dated 31.10.2008 issued by Ministry of Personnel (Public Grievances and Pensions), the Central Administrative Tribunal has jurisdiction over all the matters relating to BSNL.
3. Faced with this, counsel for the petitioner prays that matter may be transferred to Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh.
4. In the wake of statements of both sides, the registry is directed to transfer entire record of this case to Registrar, Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh.

5. At the first instance, the parties shall appear before the Tribunal on 12.02.2024.
