1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the office order No.31 dated 31.03.2022 (Annexure P-18), whereby the respondents have rejected the claim of the petitioner.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite his best efforts he has not been able to get further instructions from the LRs of the petitioner.
