NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, claiming the following reliefs:-

i) *issue a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents not to replace the petitioner having employed on the post of Tubewell Pump Operator by way of another set of temporary employee having been appointed and worked continuously since the year 2013 under the policy of the Government over the said post in village Islam Nagar, Tehsil Indri, District Karnal.*

ii) *issue a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing respondent Nos.4 and 5 to release the salary of the petitioner due from the last three-four months over the post of Tubewell Operator may without any delay and the petitioner allowed to continue over his job work of Tubewell Operator."*

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2. In the written statement filed by respondent No.5, it has been stated that the services of the petitioner had already been terminated vide resolution dated 13.05.2017 and in his place, Sh. Sachin S/o Jasmer was appointed.
3. Since neither the order of termination has been challenged by the petitioner nor Sh. Sachin S/o Jasmer has been impleaded as respondent, therefore, no relief can be granted to the petitioner in the present petition.
4. Disposed of in the above terms.
