1. Through the instant petition, prayer is made for issuance of a mandamus upon the official respondents to comply with the provisions of Section 160 Cr.P.C. by issuing 5 to 7 days' advance notice, in case the petitioners are required to join any inquiry/investigation/trial of a criminal case.

2. Today, the learned State counsel on instructions imparted to him by the official concerned that 2 GD entries have been recorded whereby, the police of District Panipat has approached the concerned Police Station for conducting raids in two different FIRs, i.e. FIR No. 86 dated 11.2.2023, under Sections 380, 457, 382, 201 IPC and under Sections 25 of the Arms Act, Police Station Sector-29, Panipat and FIR No. 304 dated 30.5.2023, under Sections 457, 380, 382, 420, 467, 468, 471, 201 IPC and under Section 25 of the Arms Act, Police Station Sector-29, Panipat.
