1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the decision taken by respondent no.2 in its meeting held on 12.01.2016 (Annexure P-5).

2. Learned counsel for respondent no.2 has pointed out that the petitioner was given 8 years to complete his course and was further given two mercy chances, which the petitioner never availed and thus, in view of the same, nothing survives in the petition.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in spite of



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best efforts, he is not able to get in touch with the petitioner and thus, the present petition be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous but liberty be granted to the petitioner to revive the same in case any cause survives.
