The explanation dated 08.11.2024 in the form of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, (STF) Ferozepur is taken on record.

2. By way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under: -

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 31.08.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation.



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4. During the course of hearing on 31.08.2024, following order had been passed: -

“ DSP Bhupinder Gill, STF (Ferozepur) who has earlier submitted the inquiry report is present in Court today and seeks time for furnishing the reply/explanation. The same be submitted on or before the next date. He is directed to remain present in Court on the next date along with Investigating Officer of the case.

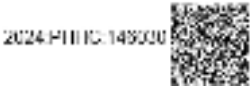
2. In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation within seven days from today and in the event of his arrest, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.

3. List on 04.10.2024.”

5. Learned State counsel on instructions received from ASI Satwant Singh informs the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

6. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 31.08.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 31.08.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

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7. The petition stands allowed.
8. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not
be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
