1. By way of instant petition filed under Section 11 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (for short “the Act”), petitioner has approached this Court for appointment of an Arbitrator.
2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was allotted work of special repair of link road vide allotment letter dated 18.05.2016, Annexure A-1 and an agreement dated 27.05.2016, Annexure A-2, was executed between him and the respondents. He submits that a dispute arose between the parties and the petitioner served a legal notice dated 11.07.2021, Annexure A-3, invoking the Arbitration Clause, but no response was received.

3. Upon notice, respondents have appeared before this Court and have not filed any reply. Counsel for the respondents has specific instructions to state that the respondents do not have any objection, in case, an Arbitrator is appointed.
4. In view of the above, prayer made in the petition is accepted. Sh. M.P. Mehndiratta, District & Sessions Judge (Retd.), resident of House No. 1090, Sector 15, Part-2, Gurgaon-122001, Mob. No. 09250925555, is appointed as the sole Arbitrator to adjudicate the dispute between the parties, subject to declaration to be made by him under Section 12 of the Act with regard to his independence and impartiality to adjudicate the dispute.
5. Parties are directed to appear before the Arbitrator on 05.04.2024 at 11:00 A.M. at the address mentioned above or at any other place to be fixed with the consent of the parties.
6. Arbitrator shall be paid fee in accordance with the Fourth Schedule of the Act, as amended.
7. Arbitrator is requested to complete the proceedings as per time limit specified under Section 29-A of the Act.
8. Copy of the order be sent to the appointed Arbitrator.
