Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as of now, no prejudice has been caused by impugned order dated 18.03.2019 (Annexure P-8) but in case later, the petitioner's services are considered afresh after his regularization so as to take away his past service to be considered under the Old Pension Scheme and not to grant the benefit of the past service hence, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to avail appropriate remedy at the time of retirement, in case benefits are denied.
