1. On 08.02.2024, the following order was passed:
- “From the perusal of record, it comes out that there was no representation of the petitioner on 18.02.2020. On 16.09.2022, the matter was adjourned and it was specifically pointed out that no further adjournment shall be granted. On account of heavy Board, the matter thereafter could not be taken up.*
- In the interest of justice, adjourned to 16.02.2024.*
- It is made clear that no further adjournment shall be granted.”*
2. Despite being called twice, there is no representation on behalf of the parties, thus, the Court is left with no option except to dismiss for non-prosecution.

3. Dismissed for non-prosecution.
