1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 2, 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 13.12.2023 passed in CWP-27935-2023.
2. Notice of motion.
3. Mr. Pawan Kumar Longia, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.
4. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 13.12.2023 passed in CWP-27935-2023 has since been complied with and necessary order dated 02.07.2024 has been passed. Copy of the order dated 02.07.2024 produced by the counsel for the respondents in the Court today, is taken on record.
5. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
6. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
