JASGURPREET SINGH PURI, J. (Oral)

1. At the outset, Ms. Rajni Gupta, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana has stated that the petitioner was transferred on administrative grounds but he has not apprised the authorities that his father is a heart patient and has undergone heart surgery and it is very difficult for him to work at a place which is 70 kms. away. She submitted that in case the petitioner files any representation to the competent authority by taking up the grounds including the aforesaid ground of sickness of his father, then the same will be considered by the competent authority in a sympathetic manner and an order will be passed in this regard.



2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in view of the aforesaid stand taken by the learned State counsel, he will file a representation to the competent authority within a period of two weeks from today but a direction may be issued to the respondents to consider and decide the representation within a time frame work by passing a speaking order and till the time, the representation is not decided, his present place of posting may not be disturbed.

3. After hearing the learned counsel for the parties and considering the aforesaid stand taken by the learned counsel for the parties, the petitioner is directed to file a representation within a period of two weeks from today to the concerned competent authority by taking up any of the grounds including the ground of sickness of his father taken in the present petition. Thereafter, the concerned competent authority shall consider and decide the same within next two weeks.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of.

5. It is further directed that till the time the representation of the petitioner is not decided by the competent authority, the petitioner will not be disturbed from his present place of posting. However, it is made clear that in case the petitioner does not file any representation within the aforesaid period of two weeks, then the aforesaid order of not disturbing him from the present place of posting will not be given effect to.
