1. Petitioner (Pardeep Kumar) has filed the instant civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, seeking directions to respondent No. 2 (Financial Commissioner, Haryana) to decide the Revision Petition (Annexure P-1), filed by one Surja (respondent No. 3 herein), titled as '*Surja Versus Pardeep Kumar and others*', against the order dated 26.12.2018, passed by Tehsil-cum-Assistant Collector Ist Grade, Israna, Tehsil Israna, District Panipat.

On advance service of copy of petition, learned State counsel appears and on instructions from Mr. Sudeep, Assistant in the office of Financial Commissioner, Haryana (respondent No. 2), submits that in all probability, the aforesaid revision petition (Annexure P-1), filed by respondent No. 3 (Surja) before respondent No. 2 (Financial Commissioner, Haryana), would be decided positively within a period of ten days from today.
