1. The present writ petition was filed in the year 2021 wherein the petitioners are claiming the benefit of antedated appointment on the post of Conductor with all the consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners have already raised the said grievance in the legal notice dated 13.01.2021 copy of which has been appended as (Annexure P-8) but even after 03 years, same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

3. Learned State counsel submits that in case, the representation 13.01.2021 (Annexure P-8) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing

an appropriate speaking order and in case, after the decision, the petitioners are found entitled for any benefit, the same will be extended to them within a further period of four weeks thereafter and if the petitioners are not entitled for any relief as claimed, due reasons be mentioned and supplied to the petitioners for their information and necessary action.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

5. Ordered accordingly.
