SUM EET GOEL, J (ORAL)

1. Case called out twice since morning but none has appeared for the petitioner.

2. On 06.11.2023, the following order was passed:-

“ Vide order dated 05.08.2022 the petitioner was granted the concession of anticipatory bail. On 23.08.2023 learned counsel for the State on instructions from SI Mohan Lal had stated that though the petitioner had joined investigation, however, he was not cooperating. The petitioner was directed to rejoin investigation and to cooperate. Today learned counsel for the State on instructions from Mohan Lal has stated that the petitioner has not rejoined investigation directed vide order dated 23.08.2023.

List on 31.01.2024.

The petitioner is granted one last opportunity to rejoin investigation and to cooperate with the Investigating Agency failing which, consequences shall follow.

Interim order to continue.”

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Manoj Kumar, submits that the petitioner has not joined the investigation despite last opportunity having been accorded to the petitioner in terms of order dated 06.11.2023.

4. Accordingly, this Court is left with no other choice but to dismiss the instant petition for want of prosecution.
5. Dismissed for non-prosecution.
