Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though, notice of motion has been issued in the present case but, the private respondents have not been served.

Learned counsel submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 20.06.2024, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-9 and the respondents be directed to decide the claim of the petitioners in the light of the Instructions issued by the State of Punjab keeping in view the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 79 of 1979 titled as ***R.K. Sabarwal and others Vs. State of Punjab and others***, decided on 19.02.1995 by passing an appropriate speaking order on the claim of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that appropriate order on the claim of the petitioners will be passed within a period of four months of the receipt of copy of this order.

It may be noticed that in case, any other employee is likely to be affected by the outcome, the said employee should also be given due opportunity to defend his/her case before passing the order.



Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
